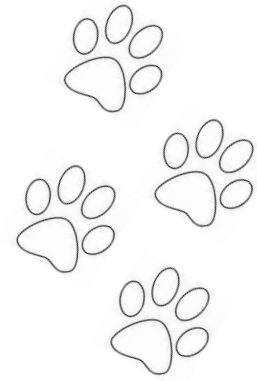

## "Baby, It's Cold Outside"

At HES we work on showing respect and being safe, organized and responsible. We call these **ROAR behaviors**. When students exhibit ROAR, they can earn a ROAR ticket and be entered into the weekly drawing for ROARING student of the week. Please take time to discuss ROAR with your child and how to carry it into common areas such as hallways, cafeteria, playground, bathroom, assemblies, and on the bus. These lessons are designed to make our school safer and more enjoyable for everyone.

It seems that Winter has finally shown her face in Harlem! Please remember that students will continue to go outside unless temperatures fall below zero. Temperatures often go up throughout the day, so we sometimes start out with indoor recess and later transition to outdoor recess.
