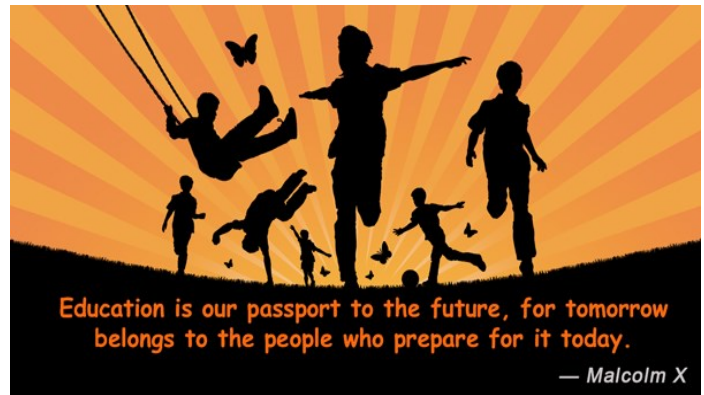
We look forward to a very positive and productive year together!
