- Lack a fixed, regular, and adequate nighttime residence. The term includes children and youth who are:
 1. Sharing the housing of other persons due ot loss of housing, economic hardship, or a similar reason (sometimes referred to as doubled-up);
 2. Living in motels, hotels, trailer parks, or camping grounds due to lack of alternative adequate accommodations;
 3. Living in emergency or transitional shelters;
 4. Abandoned in hospitals; or
 5. Awaiting foster care placement;
- Have a primary nighttime residence that is a public or private place not designed for, or ordinarily used as, a regular sleeping accommodation for human beings;
