## HOME EVENT SPECTATOR PLAN

Per the Governor's Directive, Blaine County Health Department, and Harlem School District, certain considerations must be made to protect the health and safety of our communities to the best of our ability.

### VOLLEYBALL

- If you are sick or do not feel well, please do not attend
- Each student-athlete and coaches will receive three (3) tickets to invite attendees for the home team. The visiting team AD/contact will receive a designated set number of 30 spectator tickets
  - *Note: the number of tickets may be adjusted on Senior Night*
- Spectators must show ticket at entrance or they will not be granted access into the gym (children 7 & under do not need a ticket if they are accompanied by a parent/guardian ticket holder)
- Spectator tickets do not waive fee for admission at ticket gate
- Spectators will be asked to leave their name and phone number with ticket taker in the event contact tracing is needed
- Capacity numbers will be strictly adhered to and spectators are asked to sit in pods (family/household members)
- Enter/leave through West entry except in case of emergency
- There will be a section designated for home and visiting team personnel only. Team personnel includes players, coaches, managers, bus drivers, trainers
- All team personnel are asked to sit in their designated area, please look for signs
- Please keep children seated at all times while you are in attendance except for restroom use and/or an emergency, they are not allowed to be running around
- Masks are required, please practice social distancing, except household members do not have to social distance from another household member
- Individuals should continue to practice good hygiene through hand washing or sanitizing, especially after touching frequently used items or surfaces, avoid touching your face, sneeze or cough into a tissue or inside of your elbow
- No Concessions will be available until further notice.
- Anyone NOT adhering to these guidelines will be asked to leave

### FOOTBALL

- Each student-athlete and coaches will receive four (4) tickets to invite attendees for the home team. The visiting team AD/contact will receive a designated set number of 35 spectator tickets.
  - *Note: the number of tickets may be adjusted on Senior Night*
- Spectators must show ticket at entrance or they will not be granted access into the stadium grounds (children 7 & under do not need a ticket if they are accompanied by a parent/guardian ticket holder)
- Spectator tickets do not waive fee for admission at ticket gate
- Spectators will be asked to leave their name and phone number with ticket taker in the event contact tracing is needed
- Capacity numbers will be strictly adhered to and spectators are asked to sit in pods (family/household members)
- Masks are required, please practice social distancing, except household members do not have to social distance from another household member
- Please stay in your car or sit in the bleachers socially distanced, if you choose to stand behind the rope around the field, please practice social distancing
- Please keep children seated at all times while you are in attendance except for restroom use and/or an emergency, they are not allowed to be running around and/or playing in the end zones or softball field
- Individuals should continue to practice good hygiene through hand washing or sanitizing, especially after touching frequently used items or surfaces, avoid touching your face, sneeze or cough into a tissue or inside of your elbow
- Home fans please sit on East side, visiting fans please sit on West side
- No Concessions will be available until further notice.
- Anyone NOT adhering to these guidelines will be asked to leave
