HOME EVENT SPECTATOR PLAN – WINTER ACTIVITIES (HS Basketball, HS Wrestling, & JH Boys Basketball)

Per the Governor's Directive, Blaine County Health Department, and Harlem School District, certain considerations must be made to protect the health and safety of our communities to the best of our ability.

*****Please note these guidelines are subject to change in the future. All Harlem home contests & almost all of away contests will be broadcast on NFHS Network***

- If you are sick or do not feel well, please do not attend
- If you are quarantined, please do not attend
- Visiting athletes & coaches will be allotted one (1) ticket each to invite attendees for the visiting team
- Harlem Pep Band members will be admitted into contests
- Harlem Cheerleaders & coaches and team managers will be allotted one (1) ticket each to invite attendees
- Harlem athletes (eligible) & coaches will be allotted two (2) tickets each to invite attendees
 - ***Note: the number of tickets may be adjusted on Senior Night – each senior will be allotted four (4) tickets***
- Spectators must show ticket at entrance or they will not be granted access into the gym
- Harlem students and staff must have a spectator ticket to be granted access (Children 2 & under do not need a ticket and must be accompanied by adult/guardian)
- Passes are not valid for entrance (MHSA pass, MCA pass) and must be accompanied by a spectator ticket
- Spectator tickets do not waive fee for admission at ticket gate
- Spectators will be asked to leave their name and phone number with ticket taker in the event contact tracing is needed
- Capacity numbers will be strictly adhered to. **Visiting spectators will be asked to sit in the Northwest section of bleachers in designated area. Harlem spectators will be asked to sit on the East side bleachers**
- Enter/leave through West entry except in case of emergency
- There will be a section designated for visiting team personnel, home team personnel, pep band, and cheerleaders
- All team personnel are asked to sit in their designated area, please look for signs
- Masks are required at all times, please practice social distancing, except household members do not have to social distance from another household member
- No concessions available until further notice
- Individuals should continue to practice good hygiene through hand washing or sanitizing, especially after touching frequently used items or surfaces, avoid touching your face, sneeze or cough into a tissue or inside of your elbow
- In order for our student-athletes to continue their season(s), we ask all to respect and comply with guidelines!
